

## **2022-2023 LRF Lymphoma Rounds COVID-19 Safety, Travel and Cancellation Policy**

Updated June 29, 2022

### Event Cancellation

- LRF is unable to offer a hybrid version of these programs. If LRF is unable to hold the program in person as scheduled, alternate virtual plans will be communicated to all attendees as far in advance as possible.
- Participants who test positive for COVID-19 or have a close contact test positive in the 10 days prior to the Rounds program should not travel to or attend the program.

### Vaccination

- All LRF staff, faculty, and program participants must be up to date with their vaccinations and protected against COVID-19 as defined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; as of the date of this policy, this means all attendees must have completed their primary vaccine series and at least one booster. All attendees to the program will be required to adhere to LRF's health and safety guidelines.
- All participants must provide proof of vaccination to LRF to attend the program. Additional direction on providing proof of vaccination status will be provided in advance of the program.

### On-Site Health Policy

- All participants must test negative for COVID-19 prior to travel to the program: this must be done within 24 hours of each individual Lymphoma Rounds program with a self-administered rapid COVID-19 test.
- Where possible, Lymphoma Rounds venues will allow for social distancing. In addition, LRF may limit attendance due to venue capacity. Masking will be required during all Lymphoma Rounds programs, and masks will be readily available from LRF staff throughout the program. The only time when participants will be allowed mask breaks is while they are actively consuming food.
- Lymphoma Rounds presentations and the provision of food and beverages will take place in the same room. As noted above, mask breaks will be allowed only for the consumption of food. Please note that attendees will have the option to take their dinner home in a to-go box should they choose not to eat in the room in which the program takes place. Optional networking will take place prior to the start of the formal presentations in the exhibit space located outside of the presentation room.
- Safety is at the forefront of LRF's event planning. Please note that any attendee who tests positive for COVID or reports possible symptoms after arriving to the venue will promptly be asked to leave the premises.
